

Charity IT Cup 2018 – Information

Basic Information

The Mini-Football Tournament will take place on 21.04.2018 in the Sports and Entertainment Complex on Alejová Street in Košice.

For tournament will be used official referees from Slovaks football leagues, so they will also contribute with their quality to the professional level of the tournament. Game rules are designed regarding the fact that not everyone controls the exact rules of futsal and football. The tournament is so attractive for recreational players. This is a mixed tournament of women and men, which guarantees greater attractiveness for companies and increased space for the Fair Play game.

You will find the exact rules below and they will be explained on the spot, do not hesitate to ask referees or technical staff.

Teams compositions

- For game will be used play system with a 4 + 1 (four players in the box plus one goalkeeper), with a minimum of 2 women in a team being played on the playfield.
- The teams will consist of 10 members with a minimum number of women in the team being 3.
- External team reinforcements are forbidden, and team members may only be employees of the company because it is a corporate event.

In case of a violation of this rule on external reinforcements, the organizer reserves the right to not allow a team or player to enter the tournament.

Playing system and tournament draw

Will be played in 4 groups (A, B, C, D) with 4 teams (of course, depending on the number of teams, the arrangement of teams in groups may change).

Tournament draw for group stage will take place a week prior to the start of the tournament, with the participation of a notary.

The two best teams from each group will be promoted to the quarterfinals.

The final ranking in the table determines:

1. reached points
2. score difference
3. Higher number of scored goals
4. match between teams

For the equality of points of multiple teams, a mini-table of these teams will be created and the final ranking will be the same as for ranking in the table.

Playoff phase

Group winners will meet the second best in each group according to the following key:

1A-2B, 1B-2C, 1C-2D, 1D-2A. Winner of the Match 1A-2B will meet in the semifinals with the winner of the match 1B-2C and the winner of the match 1C-2D will meet the 2nd semifinal with the winner of the match 1D-2A.

The winners of the semi-final will meet in the final of the tournament, and the rest semi-finalists will play game for the third place in the tournament.

The final ranking of the 5th to 16th place teams will determine the same attributes as in the group ranking regardless matches between.

1. reached points
2. score difference
3. Higher number of scored goals

Playing area and playing time

- Playing area is 38m x 18m or 40m x 20m goals are 3m x 2m
- Duration of the match is 2x7 minutes in group stage, 2x10 minutes in playoff, break 2 minutes.
- A timekeeper announcing expiration does not mean the end of the match. The referee can keep the team kicking a direct, corner and throw kick.
- The referee can extend the match for a maximum of one minute due to injury to the player.
- The referee shall announce the end of the match by a whistle.
- There are 4 players + 1 goalkeeper in the field, which is the minimum for the start and play of the game.
- The minimum number of players who can play a game is 3 + 1, i. After being eliminated, or after the player has left the game after injury. As the number of players is lower, the game ends, and it is in favor of a 5: 0 opponent. If the goal difference was higher in favor of a team that after winning a win, the result achieved on the field remains valid.
- Time to kick off the direct, corner, throw and gate kick is 5 seconds. A kick from a corner is done by kicking the legs from a line and must stand line. The opponent must stand from kick off at least 5m.

Players Equipment

- Allowed is only play in turf, hall or sports shoes (we do not recommend playing in hall shoes)
- The shoe will be checked by the referee before the match begins.
- Match players must enter uniform jerseys or T-shirts of the same color identified by numbers.
- It is forbidden to play in football boots

Competition Rules

The competition is played according to the applicable football rules with the following changes:

1. does not stand the position offside the game
2. The small home cannot play to the goalkeeper
3. The penalty kick is 6 meters from the goal line
4. It is forbidden to play in football boots
5. The goalkeeper must not move on the goal line in case of penalty
6. Throw kick must be kicked from the line, and the goal is valid only after touch of player.

7. After the goalkeeper's kick off from hand, through whole field, the goal is valid without the second players touch.
8. After the ball is thrown out of the hand without a touching of some players, the goal does not apply, kick off from the opponent's goal
9. In each match it is possible to substitute by handball type of all players. Substitution must be done on own side of the team, and the yellow card will be awarded to the player who has substituted badly.
10. When the team makes five accumulated fouls in one half, the player's opponent with each other foul kicks a penalty kick from six meters

SMALL HOME

- The goalkeeper who kicked the ball into the game can again touch the ball after the ball touches the player's opponent or the ball passes through the center line. After each touch of a goalie with a ball, this rule applies again. A random or kicked ball from player to own goalkeeper is not a small home.
- In the event of a violation of this rule, the referee orders an indirect free kick, from the point where the ball passes the goal area, if the goalkeeper touches the ball outside the goal area, the indirect free kick kicks from place where was touched.

SUBSTITUTION BENCH

- On the substitute bench can sit only the players and members of the team (company) who are playing the match and are on the team's list.
- Players who sit on the inverters can be punished as well as players on the pitch, according to the severity of the offense.

YELLOW AND RED CARDS

1. The Referee will show the yellow card for:

- a. intentionally hand playing
- b. intentionally kicking the ball after the game is interrupted
- c. according to own judgment of a foul
- d. for unsportsmanlike behavior (disrespect, mocking of opponent, curses)
- e. non-compliance with player rotation rules
- f. if a player violates the rules consistently
- g. words or behavior, disagrees with the referee's decision

2. The Referee will show the RED CARD for:

- a. gross intentional foul or foul from behind
- b. abuse, swear, referees appeal or insulting of the referee (insult - any physical contact with the referee, including the removal or removal of the referee's stuff)
- c. insulting the opponent (physical attack of the opponent)
- d. gross unsportsmanlike behavior (opt-in, rivalry)
- e. deliberate hand play in the event of the ball pointing to the goal or clear goal chance
- f. deliberate foul of the goalkeeper outside the goal area of a player who is in a clear goal chance

3. If a player receives a red card, it is sent off until the end of the match. The team plays weakened for 2 minutes. A player who has been sent off cannot re-enter the game and cannot even sit on the substitute bench. A substitute player may enter the game area on the instructions of the referee after two minutes have elapsed. If a goal has been scored before the two-minute penalty expires, the team can continue with the full strength.

4. If a player receives a second yellow card, he automatically receives the red card.

5. yellow card and red card can also be awarded to the player who is on the bench. The player will suffer the same penalty as if he were on the playfield. The exception is that when a red card is awarded, the team is not weakened by the player on the playfield.

6. If a player receives a red card, he automatically stops the next match or longer according to the referee judgment.

Penalty kick

- A penalty kick is played from 6m.
- In the penalty kick, all players on the playing area (excluding the player who clearly executes the penalty kick and the goalkeeper of the opponent's team) must be outside the goal area at least 3 m from the penalty kick.
- The opponent's goalkeeper must stand (not move his legs) on his own goal line unless the kick is played.
- A penalty kicker must kick the ball forward and not play it for the second time unless the ball touches another player.
- The ball is in play, as suddenly the kick is realized, that is, as suddenly the ball describes a path corresponding to the length of its circumference.
- A goal can be scored directly from the penalty kick.

For each violation of this policy by defending or attacking team player, the penalty kick must be repeated.
